## What is it like to study this course and how will I be assessed?

## What topics will I study?

This course introduces you to this leading image manipulation software, showing you how to repair images, correct colour, use layers, resize image effectively, make selections and create masks. For those with little or no experience of Photoshop. You will learn how:

- to use with the Photoshop workspace
- to crop images, and change the image and canvas size
- to use a variety of selection tools to change areas of an image
- to use layers for creative effects
- to make basic colour corrections
- about how colour is described in digital images
- to use filters for creative effects
- to repair damaged or blemished images
- to create and save images for websites

## What are the entry requirements?

No previous knowledge of Photoshop required. You will need basic computer skills.

## What facilities are there?

All computers have Adobe Photoshop CS6 on Windows 7. You can use this software outside of lesson time using the College Learning Resource Centres.
