What is it like to study this course and how will I be assessed?

This course is intended to provide students with the basic skills needed to begin and complete drawings and paintings of family members, friends or other suitable portrait subjects. Starting with drawing, progressing to painting, the course will cover a range of techniques. You will work at your own pace on your own choice of subject, using instructional handouts where required. Demonstrations, guidance and advice will be given by the tutor. You will be encouraged to learn ways to assess your own work. Informal and constructive tutorial assessments will also be given.

- Drawing media & techniques
- Painting media & techniques
- Composition
