**RE: Sports Day Arrangements - Nursery**

The school sports day is due to take place on **Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> July**, weather permitting. Currently the forecast is looking good between now and next week. Should this change, we will make a decision as to whether the sports day will go ahead on the 2<sup>nd</sup> by 8.30am at the latest on the day. If it is to be postponed due to wet weather then messages will be sent via text, Facebook, Twitter, the website and an answerphone message will be available when calling the school number, 01392 461288. As per last year, we are asking parents to loan us gazebos to shield children from the sun. In particular, it is helpful if parents could erect the gazebos. If you are able to help, please could you reply to the online form we will send you later.

Our reserve date, should Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> July not be viable, is Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> July at 10.00am.

All Nursery children are invited to take part in two races. If your child normally attends the Tuesday morning session they will be taken to the village playing field by the Nursery staff and supervised there. They will be returning to school when the Nursery races are finished. Parents are welcome to attend and watch, but please be advised that parents will be sat in a separate area from the children.

If your child does not normally attend the Tuesday morning Nursery session but would like to participate in sports day, you are welcome to bring them to the village playing field in time for a 10am start. All children will sit with the staff during the races and you will need to collect them when the races finish. We would expect this to be at approximately 11am at the latest.
