Please see the seating and pricing structure below.


There will be 80 seats available at the tables each night. The priority has been given to the families of children in the performances, and as such are now limited.



Cost £16 per table

The remaining 120 seats are available to anyone:

- £4.00 per adult
- £3.00 per child
- £10.00 for a family  
(2 adults and up to 1 child)
- £13.00 for a family  
(2 adults and up to 3 children)



Due to the space in the hall, sadly there can only be 4 chairs per table and you will not be allowed to pull up extra chairs around your table. The tables will be allocated on a first come first served basis to cast families. However, to maximise every seat if you do book a table please ensure that you are booking for 4 people, as we do not wish to have disappointed parents whilst having empty seats in the hall.

If you would like to come and watch, firstly reserve tickets via [Eventbrite](https://www.eventbrite.com), and then make your payment via [Wisepay](https://www.wisepay.com). In previous years some parents have paid for tickets but not reserved them on Eventbrite. Understandably, they were disappointed when their name wasn't on the seating plan and we did not have a place for them, so do remember to book.

This is a non-profit show, with all ticket money contributed to the school funds to pay for the costs of the performance itself. Your support of the show will be greatly appreciated.

Your tickets will be checked at the door on arriving so please make sure that you have your Eventbrite tickets printed or on your phone ready for scanning. The café will be serving refreshments before and during the interval. This means that the café will be closed to families who are not attending the show. The café will open usual time from 3.00pm.
