RE: Year 1 Trip to Living Coasts

Dear Parent,

On **Monday 12th November** Year 1 will be visiting Living Coasts, Torquay as part of their 'Frozen Planet' project. During the day they will take part in the Playful Penguin Workshop, looking at the life of penguins and how they have adapted to survive in the cold weather. For the rest of the day the children will be exploring Living Coasts and have access to a variety of events such as the Penguin Breakfast, Puffins and Pals, Otter Brunch, Stingray Feed, Octopus Feed and many more.

The children will be travelling to and from the venue by school by coach. They will be leaving school at 9.00am prompt and will be returning before the end of the school day.

The children will need to wear school uniform with sensible walking shoes, a warm coat, a hat and gloves and, depending on the weather, a waterproof coat as much of Living Coasts is outdoors. It is helpful if the children bring a small rucksack to carry their school water bottle.

As your child is entitled to free school meals, a packed lunch can be provided by the school containing:

- A sandwich – either ham and salad, tuna and cucumber or cheese and tomato
- A piece of fruit
- A cookie
- A carton of drink or water

A text will be sent, asking you to reply as to whether or not your child would like a school packed lunch and, if so, their preferred choice of sandwich filling. You are able to provide a packed lunch from home if you prefer.

The cost of the trip is **£12.00** to cover to the workshop, entry to Living Coasts and transport, and payment is to be made via Wisepay.
