RE: Year 4 Trip - Farm Wise

Dear Parent,

As part of the Year 4 Harvest work the children will be attending an event at Westpoint about farming in Devon, where they will learn about how food is produced and the role farming has in the countryside. The trip will take place during the school day on **Tuesday 16th October**.

The children will be travelling to Westpoint by coach and will need to be ready to leave at 9.00am. Therefore, we ask that your child arrives at school no later than **8.45am**. Children will be back at school before the end of the school day.

Your child will need to wear their school uniform and sensible shoes or wellington boots in case of wet and muddy conditions, but these are not essential. Please also bring an outdoor coat in case of bad weather although most of the event will be indoors.

Please could you provide your child with a packed lunch and a drink, ideally in a backpack. If your child is in receipt of free school meals a packed lunch can be provided by the school. Please order this by Thursday 11th October at main reception or by contacting admin@bcps.org.uk.

The cost of the trip is **£6.00** to cover the cost of coach hire. To make this trip viable we will need to collect contributions and may have to cancel the trip if not enough money is raised. Should this be the case contributions will be returned to parents. Please make this payment via Wisepay in the 'Trips and Visits Payments' module where you will find this trip listed.
