RE: Year 4 Belmont Chapel Trip

Dear Parent,

On **Monday 11th February** 4DL will be visiting Belmont Chapel as part of their Religious Education project, where they are investigating the question: 'What is worship and does it have to happen in a special place?'. Year 4 will be attending other places of worship throughout the year. Children will be asked to present their discoveries about the Chapel once back at school.

The children will be travelling to the venue in minibuses. They will be leaving the school at 1.10pm and should return at approximately 2.45pm. The children will be provided time to eat before going on this trip.

During their time at the Chapel the children will be taken on a guided tour that explores the building as a place of worship. Pupils will discover why the chapel is a special place and gain a deeper understanding of the Christian faith.
