Re: Year 4 Trip to Morwellham Quay

Dear Parent,

Year 4 will be visiting Morwellham Quay, a working village, mine and craft centre near Tavistock, on **Tuesday 12th March** as part of their history topic. The purpose of the visit is to learn about life in the Victorian times.

To make the most of the time available for the visit we ask that your child **arrives at school by 8.15am**, ready to **depart at 8.30am prompt**. This will help us to ensure the car park is clear before the morning school drop off. We expect the children to arrive back at school by **4.30pm** and, should there be any delays due to traffic, we will notify you by text.

Your child will need a packed lunch for the trip. If your child is in receipt of a free school meal, a packed lunch can be provided by the school and an online form will be sent to you to complete.

The cost of the trip is £15 per child, to cover entry to the centre, workshops and coach transport. To make this trip viable we will need to collect contributions and may have to cancel the trip if not enough money is raised. Should this be the case, contributions will be returned to parents. Payment is to be made via Wisepay.
