RE: Year 4 Escot Residential Trip – Final Arrangements

Dear Parent,

I am writing with details of the final arrangements for the Year 4 Escot residential trip.

The children will need to arrive at school by **9.00am on Thursday 9th May** in their casual clothes, ready to depart for the trip at 9.30am. Children should leave bags and sleeping bags on the front playground space (away from the pathway please), ready to be loaded onto the coach. They will also need a packed lunch but will be provided with an evening meal on Thursday and then breakfast and lunch on the Friday. Children will return to school on Friday 10th May at **4.30pm**. If there is any delay, you will be notified by text message.

Children will need to bring old clothes for the swamp walk, with a named plastic bag to keep them in. A kit list has been provided for the trip (see below), however, if you have any queries please contact Dale Lawson dlawson@bcps.org.uk and Sammi Pearson spearson@bcps.org.uk

Any medication required, including inhalers and the accompanying medical forms need to be in a clear labelled bag and handed to a member of staff before departure. The 'Administration of Medicines' and 'Medicine in the Last 24 Hours' forms are attached for you to complete if needed. You must complete the 'Administration of Medicines' form, if you have not already done so, to give us your consent to administer any medication required and we also need to ensure that you have notified us of what medicines you have given your child over the previous 24 hours.

Residential Camp Kit List

One bag with all your gear:

A thick sleeping bag or duvet, pillow and thick blanket

A single bed sheet (*waterproof if child is known to wet the bed*)

A small rucksack for day time activities

Suitable outdoor clothing

Rain coat (and rain trousers if possible)

Flip flops for showers (not suitable for daytime activities)

A tea towel, to use as a place mat at picnic times

A towel and toiletries

A torch

Refillable water bottle

Sun tan lotion and a sun hat

Outdoor footwear/trainers/hiking boots/ Wellington boots

Swamp walk clothes and a named plastic bag for dirty clothes

Slippers for inside yurts (optional)

A pencil and notebook or reading book (optional)

Camera (optional - at own risk)

Please do not bring any electronics or mobile phones to Yurt Village

PLEASE NOTE IF YOUR CHILD HAS A THIN SLEEPING BAG, PLEASE PACK A DUVET INSTEAD IN A BLACK BIN LINER TO MAKE SURE YOUR CHILD STAYS WARM
