Dear Parents,

Your child's year group has the opportunity to attend the Kingfisher Awards Field Day on **Wednesday 22nd May**. This is taking place at Dalditch Farm, Budleigh Salterton, with one class visiting in the morning and the other in the afternoon.

The trip will take place during the school day but will require the children to bring suitable clothing and boots. Given that the half day of activities is outdoors they will need to be prepared for the weather, so should bring a sun hat, sun cream, wellington boots and a waterproof jacket.

Class 4SP will be travelling by coach and will be leaving at 11.00am. They will return at the end of the school day. Your child will need to come into school in their uniform and bring their change of clothes with them.

Please could you provide your child with a packed lunch and a drink in a refillable bottle as they will be able to have lunch from 12.00pm to 12.30pm at the farm. If your child is in receipt of free school meals, please could you reply to the online form we will send later.

The project this year is 'Muck, Milk and Minibeasts'. Children will be looking at the importance of soil to farmers, whatever crops they are growing, and about how cows turn fields of grass into milk for us to drink.
