RE: Year 5 Trip to Cheddar Gorge

Dear Parent,

On **Monday 25th February** Year 5 will be going to 'Cheddar Gorge' to support the work in their Bronze Age project.

During the day the children will have a focused prehistoric workshop, visit the prehistoric museum, have a tour of Gough's cave, take the flight up Jacob's ladder and watch the virtual tour of the history of the caves. The venue is the perfect place for a prehistoric workshop, giving them the basis of knowledge to support their future writing about the period and preparation for the residential at Heatree Activity Centre in May.

The children will be travelling to and from the venue by coach. They will be leaving school at approximately 8.30am and will be returning at approximately 5.00pm. We therefore ask that your child be at school by **8.00am** to ensure a timely departure.

Please could you provide your child with a packed lunch and a drink, ideally in a backpack. If your child is in receipt of free school meals, please complete the online form we will send you to let us know whether you would like the school to provide your child with a packed lunch.

Please note that many elements of this session take place outdoors so please ensure children are dressed appropriately for the weather conditions, including a coat and suitable footwear.

The cost of the trip is £17.00 to cover to the tour, workshop and transport. To make this trip viable we will need to collect contributions, via WisePay, and may have to cancel the trip if not enough money is raised. Should this be the case contributions will be returned to parents.
