RE: Year 5 Trip to the Eden Project

Dear Parent,

On **Thursday 20th June** Year 5 will be visiting the Eden Project as part of their biology project, where they are investigating sustainability, linked to their upcoming Killerton performance.

To make the most of the time available for the visit we ask that your child **arrives at school by 7.45am**, ready to depart at 8.00am prompt. This will help us to ensure the car park is clear before the morning school drop off. We expect the children to arrive back at school by 5.30pm and, should there be any delays due to traffic, we will notify you by text.

During their time at the Eden Project the children will be exploring both the rainforest and Mediterranean biomes, and the new invisible worlds' exhibition – which reveals the world beyond our senses. In addition to this, the children will be taking part in the Sustainability Sussed workshop, which will challenge them to go on a journey and reflect on their foods and the impact we have on our earth.

Your child will need a packed lunch for the trip. If your child is in receipt of a free school meal, a packed lunch can be provided by the school and an online form will be sent to you to complete.

The cost of the trip is £15 per child, to cover entry to the centre, workshops and coach transport. To make this trip viable we will need to collect contributions and may have to cancel the trip if not enough money is raised. Should this be the case, contributions will be returned to parents. Payment is to be made via Wisepay.
