RE: Year 6 Activity Week, 10th – 14th June 2019

Dear Parent,

Further to the parents' meeting on the 1st November last year I am writing with further details of the activity week offered at Heatree House in June. During the week, the children will have opportunities to develop not only their personal qualities but also their team building qualities – essential skills in today's world. The activities described below reflect the demands of the PE curriculum and the Personal and Social Development curriculum.

The programme we have set out will provide a number of activities including rope courses, abseiling, canoeing, orienteering and archery. Fully qualified instructors in small, well-supervised groups will be running each of these. A number of the school staff will be staying with the children during the whole of the week.



The activity week will be based at Heatree House, an activities centre on Dartmoor near Manaton. The centre is set in a beautiful location within its own grounds of several acres. It is not far from Hound Tor and facilities on site are excellent.

We try to encourage all the children to participate in these opportunities as each provides a tremendous way of developing personal qualities in the children that would otherwise be difficult to establish.

The cost for the week is £290 - this includes all transport, activities, food and accommodation.

Heatree house is well furnished and the children stay in small en-suite bedrooms. The rooms sleep about 4 in bunk beds and are all en-suite.



If you would like your child to participate in this activity week, please complete the online emergency contact details and consent form we will send to you tomorrow.

If your child is on any medication at the time they go on this residential, you will need to complete an 'Administration of Medicines' form to give us your consent to administer any required medication. We will also need to know any medicines you have given your child over the previous 24 hours. On the day of departure, please bring the medication and both forms in a bag labelled with your child's name and give it to one of the members of staff going on the residential.

We will need full payment via WisePay by **Wednesday 1st May 2019**. **Please could you pay the deposit of £80 by Sunday 24th February**. Further instalments are due on the 31st March 2019 (£120) and 1st May 2019 (£90).
