RE: SATs Meeting and Revision Guides

Dear Parent,

As you may be aware, children in Year 6 will be taking their Statutory Assessment Tests (SATs) in the summer term. These assessments are a one off “snapshot” of your child’s achievements and form only a part of the school’s assessment of your child’s overall performance.

During the week commencing 13th May children will sit tests in:

- Reading
- Maths
- Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar

The tests are both set and marked externally. In addition to this, writing is judged by teacher assessment and moderated by external assessors.

As a reminder, there will be a meeting on **Monday 11th March at 7.00pm in the hall**. This will provide you with an opportunity to hear the recent updates to the SATs and see examples of the tests and tasks. Myself, Mr James, Miss Williams and Mr Pitts will be available to answer any questions.

Your child will shortly be bringing home some revision guides for Maths, Reading and Grammar Punctuation and Spelling. They are a child friendly study guide, filled with the information required to complete their SATs. The revision guides are to be used for study, reference and to consolidate ideas looked at in class. **They are numbered and assigned to each child and will need to be returned after the SATs have finished. Therefore, we ask that these books are not written in. Answers to the questions are to be written in the exercise books provided.**
