RE: BCPS Life Skills Day - Year 6

Dear Parents,

For those children not attending the Netherlands residential, there is an opportunity to attend a Life Skills course at The Sidmouth Donkey Sanctuary on **Wednesday 26th June** during the afternoon. This course is organised by Devon and Cornwall Police and is run especially for children transferring into secondary education. Children taking part in the Netherlands residential will attend the Life Skills course on a different date.

Your child will need to wear school uniform, and bring a waterproof coat, sun cream and hat if hot, and sensible footwear. Your child will also need to bring a packed lunch. If your child is in receipt of free school meals, please could you reply to the online form we will send you later to let us know whether you would like to school to provide your child with a packed lunch.

The children will be travelling to and from the Donkey Sanctuary by minibus. The session starts at 1.00pm and the children should arrive back at school by **4.15pm**. We will notify you by text if there are any delays on the day, eg due to traffic.

The cost of the trip is £5.50 to cover the cost of transport. To make this trip viable we will need to collect contributions, via WisePay, and may have to cancel the trip if not enough money is raised. Should this be the case contributions will be returned to parents.
