**RE: Football Boots for After School Activities – Year R**

Dear Parent,

Now that the wetter winter weather is upon us, I would like to highlight the need for your child to wear football boots when participating in football or rugby as an after-school activity. Although boots are required from Year 1 upwards for games sessions this is required from a safety perspective.

If boots are not brought in for an after-school activity, then you will be called and asked to collect your child at the end of the school day as they will not be able to participate safely. If collection is not possible, then your child will be taken to the After School Slub and you will be invoiced for the cost of the childcare provision.

We know that purchasing boots can be a significant cost and so we have asked if parents are willing to donate old football boots for other parents to utilise rather than have the full cost of purchasing. Please could you put donated football boots in a bag labelled with your child's name so that, if they are not required by another parent, they can be returned to you.
