**RE: Reception Class 'Road Safety' walk**

Dear Parent,

In BCPS and WCPS Reception our new project is based around the theme 'People Who Help Us'. This is a great opportunity for children to learn about a variety of different job roles and what everybody in our community does to help us. This week in particular, we are focussing on 'Road Safety'. We have been learning how to keep safe on the roads from job roles such as a lollipop person, traffic warden, police and road workers.

Tomorrow and Thursday this week, children from both BCPS and WCPS Reception classes will be in small groups and asked to walk around the local village area so they can practise their 'Stop, Look and Listen' skills. We want to show the children the importance of listening to adults, crossing roads only when it is safe to do so and always be looking and listening for traffic, highlighting the dangers it can bring.

Children will only be going on a small walk so school shoes will be appropriate, however, if you would like to provide them with trainers or wellies for the walk then please bring them in a spare bag for the day. All children will need a warm, waterproof coat. If it is raining, then we will make a judgement to postpone on the day as we do not wish to take them out in this weather.
