RE: World War II Themed Day

Dear Parent,

I am writing to let you know that on **Friday 16th November** Year 2 will be holding a World War 2 theme day.

The children will re-enact a day in the life of a child during the war, and will take part in:

- Tasting food that would have been cooked during WWII
- Building an Anderson shelter
- Listening to air raid sirens and acting accordingly
- Looking and researching WWII artefacts
- Listening to a range of music from WWII

Your child is invited to come to school dressed as a WWII evacuee, or wearing clothes from the 1940s.



Boys could wear a shirt, tank-top, jumper, blazer, long socks, knee-length shorts or trousers, a cap or woollen hat.

Girls could wear a knee-length dress or skirt with a blouse, cardigan, beret, headscarf or hat.

These are suggestions only, and dressing up is not compulsory, intended to be a costly or an onerous task.
