RE: RHS Rosemoor – Year 2

Dear Parent,

I am writing to inform you that on **Thursday 21st March** Year 2 will be visiting the RHS Garden at Rosemoor. As part of their current project on plants the children are going to explore the gardens and take part in a range of exciting workshops. They will taste some different fruit and vegetables and discuss how they feel, sound and taste. Alongside this they will identify different types of plant and discuss their lifecycles.

The trip is covered by the general consent form and the children will be travelling to and from the venue by coach. They will be leaving school at 9.15am and will be returning at 4.55pm. Please could you ensure that your child arrives at school **before 9.00am** to allow us to be ready for a prompt departure. You will be able to collect your child from their **Year 2 classroom at 4.55pm**.

As your child is entitled to free school meals, a packed lunch can be provided by the school containing:

- A sandwich – either ham and salad, tuna and cucumber or cheese and tomato
- A piece of fruit
- A cookie
- A carton of drink or water

Please could you reply to the online form we will send you later to let us know whether your child would like a school packed lunch and, if so, their preferred choice of sandwich filling. You are able to provide a packed lunch from home if you prefer.

The cost of the trip is £10 in total. This includes the voluntary contribution of £3 entry to the garden and transport. To make this trip viable we will need to collect contributions, via WisePay, and may have to cancel the trip if not enough money is raised. Should this be the case contributions will be returned to parents.
