COLLECTION OF CHILDREN

KS1 children will need to change out of their costumes prior to going home and therefore are likely to be available for collection at approximately 4.30pm. Please wait at the back of the classrooms where the children will be released to you once they are changed.

On Tuesday 5th, Wednesday 6th and Thursday 7th December, all after school activities will be cancelled due to the number of staff involved in the Nativities. However, the paid for after school care provision will still be available. Please book and pay via Wisepay. **Due to the disruption it will cause, we ask that parents and other family members do not leave the nativity performances to collect siblings at 3.30pm.**

PERFORMANCES

The doors will be open at 8.30am for the 9.30am Nursery performance, 9.00am for the 10.00am KS1 Nativity performance and at 2.00pm for the 3.00pm KS1 Nativity performance. The Academy Café will be open prior to the performances for you to purchase refreshments if you wish. There will be mince pies available as well as the usual array of goodies.

Please bring with you your pre-ordered tickets either on a mobile device or printed. Each ticket has an individual bar code, matched to your booking. The tickets will be scanned upon entrance to the hall.

Please note that older siblings from the school will not be able to watch the performances.

PARKING

There will be no parking on site for these performances. This includes those requiring disabled parking as we only have a very limited number of spaces. We will, however, be offering the facility for dropping off audience members in the drop off zone, as we do with the children in the morning at start of school. This will be supervised to ensure a smooth operation. If parking remains an issue, please contact Reception or email admin@bcps.org.uk.

Due to the performances finishing after 3.30pm the café will not be open after school on **Wednesday and Thursday**.
