**RE: Year 3 Residential Meeting**

Dear Parent,

I am writing to remind you that, as listed on the dates letter, we will be holding a meeting on **Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> November at 7pm** in the school hall to talk to you about the upcoming opportunity for your child to take part in an overnight residential at Rock and Rapid, South Molton, North Devon.



Last year was the first time we offered this residential and it was a great success. The residential provides the children with the valuable experience of a night away. A number of the school staff will be staying with the children during the visit.

All pupils will have the opportunity to participate in a range of activities including low ropes and building a shelter at the end of their woodland walk. Furthermore, pupils will have to work together, developing their teamworking and communication skills.

Your child has the opportunity to take part in the residential on either **Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> – Friday 15<sup>th</sup> or Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> – Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2019**. The groups will be organised based on availability and friendship groups in order to ensure that pupils can maximise the opportunities offered by this trip. **The cost for the residential is £80**. This includes all transport, activities, food and accommodation. **Please could you pay the deposit of £40 via WisePay by Friday 30<sup>th</sup> November**. Full payment is due via WisePay by **Monday 4<sup>th</sup> February 2019**.

If you would like your child to participate in this activity, please fill in the attached emergency contact details and consent and return them to Mark Harrison or Michael Kimber.

If your child is on any medication at the time they go on this residential, you will need to complete an 'Administration of Medicines' form to give us your consent to administer any required medication. We will also need to know any medicines you have given your child over the previous 24 hours. On the day of departure, please bring the medication and both forms in a bag labelled with your child's name and give it to one of the members of staff going on the residential.

If you have any other questions please do get in touch, although I hope that as many of you as possible can attend the parents' evening where a lot of information, including the kit list, will be discussed.
