Dear Parent,

This year, as part of the Eggy Challenge, your child will be constructing a powered boat to transport an egg. In order to enhance their understanding of boats and water safety Year 3 will be going on a trip to Exmouth on **Wednesday 19th June**. During the day, the children will have the opportunity to speak to lifeguards on the beach as well as go on a tour of the lifeboat centre itself. Please note that this trip will be within normal school hours.

We will be having lunch in Exmouth so please provide your child with a packed lunch and a drink in a refillable bottle. If your child is in receipt of free school meals, please could you reply to the online form we will send you later to let us know whether you would like the school to provide your child with a packed lunch.

In order to make sure your child is safe throughout the day, we will not be allowing anyone to go into the sea itself, so school uniform will be required. Please ensure your child brings a coat or sun cream, depending on the weather.
