Dear Parent,

Your child has been chosen to take part in 'Forest School' (www.forestschoools.com) this term. This is part of the curriculum for Year 3 pupils and all will have a chance to be involved over the course of the year. Miss Smith will be leading the sessions.

Every Tuesday your child will need to bring a set of outdoor clothes, including long trousers, long sleeved jumper, waterproof coat and trousers (if possible) and wellies or walking shoes. These sessions will be run on site in the orchard and within school hours.

The philosophy of Forest School is to encourage and inspire individuals of any age through positive outdoor experiences. By participating in engaging, motivating and achievable tasks and activities in a woodland environment each participant has an opportunity to develop self-motivation and their emotional and social skills. These, through self-awareness, can be developed to reach personal potential.

Forest Schools have demonstrated success with children of all ages who visit the same local woodlands on a regular basis who through play and outdoor skills acquisition, have the opportunity to learn about the environment, how to handle risks and most importantly to use their own initiative to solve problems and co-operate with others.

The first session will be Monday 26th February and the sessions will run each week until Monday 26th March.
