Dear Parent,

On **Tuesday 20th November** the children in the Art Squad have the opportunity to visit Bristol and take part in a street art tour, looking at art works by artists such as Banksy, JPS, Cheo and Nick Walker. This will be followed by a spray painting workshop where the children will create their own stencilled piece of art.

Please note that many elements of this session take place outdoors so please ensure children are dressed appropriately for the weather conditions, including a coat and suitable footwear. It is advisable for the children to wear old clothes, or bring a change of clothes to wear during the painting workshop, as it may be messy.

The trip is covered by the general consent form and the children will be travelling to and from the venue by school minibus. They will be leaving school at 9.00am and will be returning at approximately 3.00pm. Please could you ensure that your child arrives at school at **8.30am** ready for a prompt departure.

Please could you provide your child with a packed lunch and a drink, ideally in a backpack.

The cost of the trip is £18.00 to cover to the tour, workshop and transport. To make this trip viable we will need to collect contributions, via WisePay, and may have to cancel the trip if not enough money is raised. Should this be the case contributions will be returned to parents.
