The Killerton Chapel Carol Concert will take place on **Monday 10th December at 7.00pm**. This concert is an annual event for invited guests only; we invite guests who work closely with the school during the year. It is a prestigious event and we are proud to have the children of the Chamber Choir represent the school in this way. Unfortunately, we do not have the space to invite parents as well. However, the children are performing at Poltimore House on Thursday 6th December at 6.00pm and again on Tuesday 18th December at 10.00am, along with the other school choirs, in the school hall which you are welcome to attend.

The children can remain in school at the end of the day on Monday 10th, so they can have a rehearsal and get changed into their performance clothes.
