RE: Kids' Cup – Final Information

Dear Parent,

I am writing to remind you of important information previously provided about the Kids Cup Final this Saturday, 25th May, including information the organisers have asked us to pass on.

The children will be travelling to Wembley Stadium by minibus on Friday morning, with Mark Harrison and Luke Abrahams. You will see your child at the stadium on Saturday. We have been informed that all children will be travelling home with their parents.

- A reminder that footwear for the Final is ASTRO trainers only. No blades, studded/moulded boots are permitted under Wembley's policy. Any player that has not got Astro trainers runs the risk of not being able to play (see attached). Shin pads are also required.
- It is recommended that your child takes a camera or a phone in order to take some photos on the tour.
- Please could your child bring a small amount of spending money as they will have the opportunity to visit the Wembley store.
- The weather is looking warm and sunny on Saturday, therefore please ensure that your child brings sun cream.
- Your child does not need to wear school uniform to travel to London. Please remember to pack sufficient, appropriate clothing for the overnight stay.

If you have any final questions, please contact Mark Harrison mark.harrison@tcat.education and not the organisers, as all queries must come via the school. It has been brought to my attention that, despite previous requests, some parents have contacted the organisers directly.
